Joseph Savino, 86, of Bayport, died April 2. Born and raised in the Bronx, Mr. Savino moved to Bayport in 1960. He worked as an electrician and technician at Brookhaven National Laboratory for 35 years. As a hobby, he created many ingenious inventions for his house and many toys and rides for his grandchildren. Mr. Savino was also ahead of his time with his hobby of converting gas-powered cars to electric power starting in the early 1970s.
