

Obituary: Doris E. (“Dorry”) Tooker

Doris E. Tooker, who joined BNL’s Director’s Office in 1983, and retired on May 15, 2000, from the Energy, Environment, and National Security Directorate, passed away on January 11, 2015. She was 78 years old.



Dorry’s family held a Celebration of Life on January 17, and the Carriage House of the Old South Haven Church in Brookhaven hamlet could barely contain all those who came to remember her.

While a staff specialist in BNL’s Office of Technology Transfer, Dorry Tooker won the 1994 Representative of the Year Award from the Federal Laboratory Consortium for technology Transfer, a volunteer organization of over 600 federal research laboratories, which work together to promote the rapid movement of federal technology research and development into the mainstream of the the U.S. economy.
